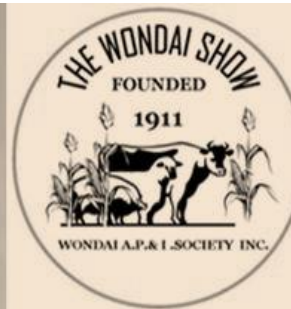

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

TICK STATUS – The DPI advises:

Tick Free –All Cattle must be TICK FREE

Infected zone – cattle to be inspected by an accredited Certifier

At risk – owners have own obligation to ensure no bio security is posed by moving cattle

1. All cattle must be fitted with a NLIS device. Scanning will be conducted on Friday 22nd August and Saturday 23rd August prior to the commencement of Judging.
2. All exhibits must be bona fide property of the exhibitor.
3. Age of cattle taken from 1st day of the month of the affiliated Show. (i.e. 01/08/2025).
4. All cattle over four (4) months of age must have a nose grip and all bulls over 12 months must have a nose ring. An exhibitor or representative **MUST** be in charge of all stock at all times.
5. All exhibitors must have Public Liability Insurance & to have same endorsed for travelling to the Show. Also to provide documentation with nominations
6. Stewards have the right to remove any animal from the show ring if that animal is a danger to the safety of the other handlers, members of the public & other animals.
7. Entries to compete in one (1) Class only, except Group Classes.
8. Judging will be conducted in three (3) categories as follows:
1) - Tropical 2) - European 3) - British
9. Two (2) Judging Rings will operate as directed by the Chief Steward
10. Judging in each ring will be in order set in the schedule unless changed at discretion of Chief Steward
11. **All entries to be received by 5.00 pm Monday 18th August.** Only entries completed using the **Official STUD BEEF ENTRY FORM** will be accepted. Entry forms may be downloaded from:

PLEASE NOTE: Late fee of \$4 per head will be applied to late entries.

12. **Inside cattle stalls** can be **booked**, whilst still available, if nominations are put in on time & paid in full through Beef Co-ordinator Jasmine Thornes
13. All Champions are required for judging of the Supreme Champion and Top 5 Exhibits.
14. Led Steers/Heifers to be weighed at 7am on the morning of the Show 23rd August 2025

15. **Young Judges and Young Handlers judging** starts at 5pm Friday 22nd August after Classes 1 & 2. All other judging starts at 8.30 am Saturday 23rd August 2025 and will be concluded prior to Grand Parade.
16. QCAS Rules must be followed.
17. Calves on cows must be 8 months and under.
18. All cattle are to remain on the Grounds until the Grand Parade is complete. If exemption is required please see the Chief Steward Josh Steinhardt

A **SCHOOL COMPETITION** runs during the evening.

All schools present & showing cattle are eligible to nominate for the **Schools Competition on Friday night.**

The competition is judged in conjunction with the Young Judges & Young Paraders. Points are awarded to the top five competitors in each class & the school they represent. 1st 5 points, 2nd 4 points, 3rd 3 points, 4th 2 points & 5th 1 point. At the completion of judging, the school that has accumulated the most points will be declared the winner. All prizes will be awarded on a sliding scale (at the discretion of the Chief Steward), with every school participating in the competition sharing in the total prize pool.

STUD BEEF CATTLE JUDGING

All cattle are to be on grounds by 6.30am Saturday 23rd August 2025 for Stewards to complete the scanning. **Judging Starts at 8.30 am**

Judging will be conducted in THREE CATEGORIES (Tropical, European & British) across TWO JUDGING RINGS as directed by the Chief Steward

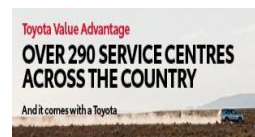
