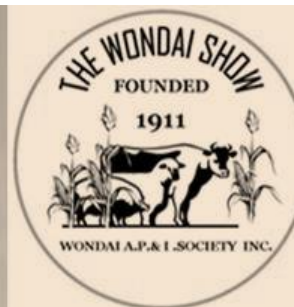

Rules and Regulations

- ALL EXHIBITORS MUST PAY THE GATE FEE ON ENTRY TO THE GROUNDS
- No Stables available
- **Hacks, Galloways & Ponies may be measured Saturday. (8.00 am to 8.30 am)**
- The following DEFINITIONS and CONDITIONS shall apply:
 - PONY - Not exceeding 14 hands
 - GALLOWAY - Over 14 hands and not exceeding 15 hands
 - HACK - Over 15 hands
 - MAIDEN - A horse that has not won a first prize at an Agricultural Show excluding local and district classes
- In the event of a dispute, the Rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies shall apply. A protest must be lodged at the secretary's office in writing with a bond of \$100.00 no later than 1 hour after the judging of the event in which the protest is to be made. The bond will be forfeited if the protest is turned down and refunded if the protest is upheld
- All competitors compete at their own risk
- All stallions and colts 1 year and over must be lead or ridden by a person 18 years or over
- Any prize not claimed during the show will be forfeited to the society
- Registration certificates & membership cards must be produced on request to the Judge in all classes
- The Judge shall withhold any prize ribbon when the exhibit is not of sufficient merit
- Exhibitors in the wrong classes may be transferred to the correct class at the discretion of Chief Ring Steward
- The Society reserves the right to substitute special prizes which may be donated later for any advertised schedule prizes
- The Society reserves the right to amend the schedule at any time
- District events are restricted to the residents of the South Burnett Regional Council area
- The show hunter classes are supported by the Australian Hunter Horse Association (AHHA). Wondai show 2022 is an AHHA Show National Qualifier. You **MUST** be a financial member to compete in the AHHA classes
- Horses/ponies and handlers competing in the Restricted Ring may not compete in the Open breed/hack/hunter rings (except in classes as indicated).
- All competitors must sign the Indemnity Forms & Horse Health Declarations to enable entry into classes - parents or guardians to sign for competitors under 18 years of age
- **PONIES may be ridden by adults**

NOTE: Horses may compete as EITHER Ridden Show Hacks or Ridden Hunters

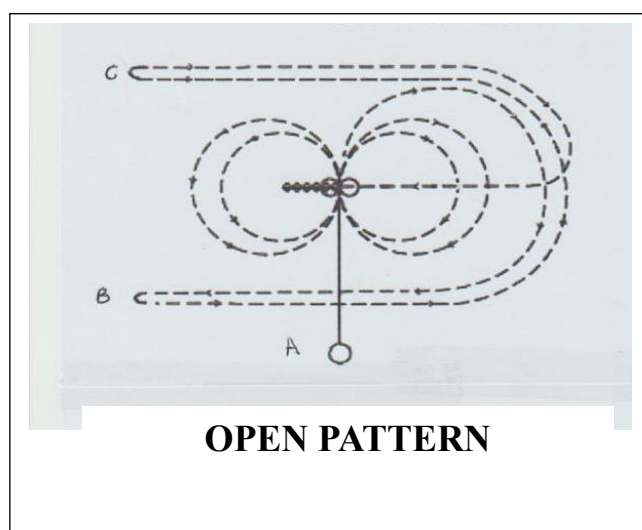

OPEN PATTERN

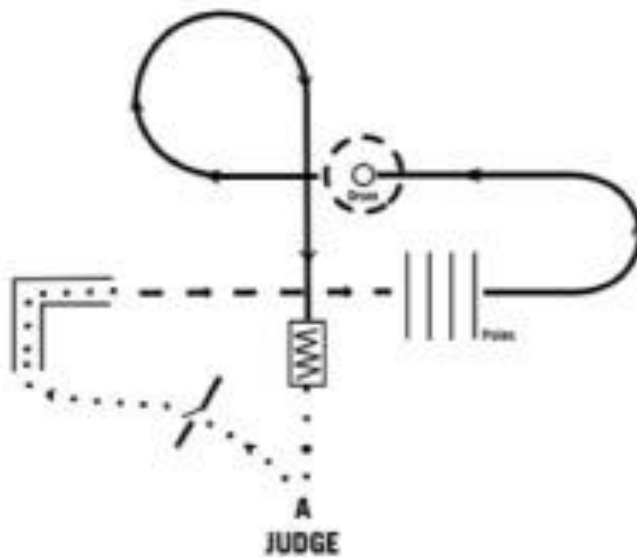
1. Enter arena at A, acknowledge Judge, walk to centre on loose rein cracking whip
2. 2 spins right
3. 2 spins left
4. Canter small slow circle right, canter large fast right
5. Flying change, canter large fast to left
6. Canter small slow circles to left
7. Flying change, canter large fast right, do not close circle
8. Run down and stop between centre line and B, roll back to left, canter around arena
9. Run down & stop between centre line and C, roll back to right, canter to end of arena, turn down centre line
10. Canter down & stop at least 3 metres past centre line, settle horse, back up to centre, acknowledge Judge & leave arena at walk on loose rein

JUNIOR STOCKMAN'S CHALLENGE PATTERN



1. Type, presentation and overall impression
2. Walk from A to B
3. Trot circle right back to B
4. Canter circle left
5. At B change lead (select simple or flying change)
6. Canter circle right
7. At B change lead (alternate style to point 5)
8. Hand gallop part circle left to C
9. At C halt facing Judge and settle
10. Walk back to Judge on a light rein

OBSTACLE COURSE

1	Type, Presentation and Overall Impression	10	
2	Walk to gate	10	
3	Pass through gate, keeping hand on gate at all times	10	
4	Walk onto L shapes poles and walk through	10	
5	Trot to and over 4 poles on ground	10	
6	Canter left lead ½ circle to drum and pick up coat	10	
7	Trot around drum and replace coat on drum	10	
8	Canter circle to the right and straight to square	10	
9	Stop in square and rein back 3 metres	10	
10	Walk back to Judge on loose rein	10

I AGREE TO ENSURE THAT:

1. All horses will be shampooed, rinsed and allowed to dry, and their hooves will be picked clean of all solid material and washed with shampoo.
2. All vehicles and equipment accompanying the horses will be cleaned to remove all solid material that could contain disease agents, and then disinfected.

I FURTHER DECLARE THAT:

3. The information contained in this Biosecurity Declaration is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.
4. I agree to abide by all conditions that may be imposed at any time by the Event Organising Committee/Manager.
5. I acknowledge that in failure to comply, I may be directed to leave and my nominations will be forfeited.
6. I acknowledge that decontamination and disinfection procedures may be required of me if instructed by the Event Organising Committee/Manager.
7. I acknowledge that there is a possibility that horses might become infected with disease agents as a result of any movements and if necessary horses and premises will be quarantined in accordance with any Legislation covering such occurrences including policies and procedures in effect at that time. I agree and acknowledge that the Manager/Event Organising Committee, its State or National Affiliated bodies and their members are not in any way liable for any cost, expense, loss, damage, claim, action, proceeding or other liability incurred by or made against me as a result of any movement of horses to the Event/Farm.
